In the last days of December, we procured from Saint Benedict Church in Saint Benedict, Iowa, wainscoting. Saint Benedict parish was closed in the summer of 2017 and the building is scheduled for demolition. This is a dual effort that not only helps our parish to save money on materials but also preserves some portion of this frontier church that was established by German settlers in the 1890s. While it is always sad to see an aged parish close and historic building set to be razed, projects such as our perpetual adoration chapel will only strengthen our parish, and our efforts to repurpose materials from Saint Benedict will carry its memory forward.
